

Siblings Without Rivalry[™]

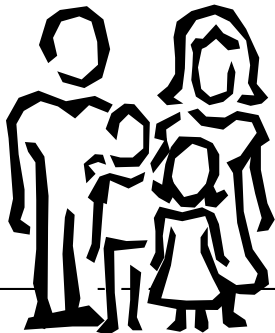
Parenting Workshop • South Cobb Regional Library
